Sabine Degroote began her musical studies on the viola at the CNR in Grenoble, at the conservatoire in Gennevilliers and Boulogne, and then at the Conservatoire Supérieur in Paris.

She then turned to singing. Trained in Paris with famous opera singers, Master class with Christa Ludwig, chamber music class with Laurence Equilbey (Accentus Chorus).

She was unanimously awarded first prize in the 1996 U.F.A.M. international competition, and first prize in the lyric art class at the Schola Cantorum in 1999.

Sabine performs in recital and as soloist with various choirs and instrumental ensembles, including the Atelier des Musiciens du Louvre. In addition, it offers performances (public and private concerts, ceremonies, etc.) in a variety of styles and formations.

With a passion for transmitting her knowledge, she has been sharing the fruits of her pedagogical research for the last 20 years through courses and workshops for all ages, styles and levels in the Grenoble region.
